

Located on the east coast of Shikoku, Tokushima can be accessed in an hour flight from Tokyo and about 2 hours drive on the highway from Kyoto and Osaka. Tokushima has a mild climate throughout year and is blessed with many rivers such as the Yoshinogawa river that runs through the center of the prefecture from east to west.

With a clear blue sky, blue transparent ocean, canyons formed by Yoshinogawa river, Oboke Koboke with a shining jade color river, rarely-visited Iya Gorge and mountains, Tokushima is an area surrounded by a beautiful natural environment with one of the world's three largest tidal currents, "Naruto whirlpool", at its northern part and Japan's largest "Sennen Sango" (Thousand Year Coral) at its southern part.

Tokushima's unique culture embodied in "Awa Odori Dance" and "Awa Joruri puppet theater" combines with the hospitality culture (osettai) where local people receive pilgrims with hospitality in a display of tradition that dates back twelve centuries.

Tokushima's aquatic environment, green scenery and

hospitality spirit harmoniously combine into a space where the convention city, the rich natural environment and the traditional culture offer the perfect stage for your convention.

Tokushima has both a history as a water city and as a castle town but equally possesses modern metropolitan function. At the center of the city a large-sized multi-purpose hall with a seating capacity of 5000 people along with more than 20 convention and accommodation facilities such as city hotels and business hotels compactly gathered together allow for various convention possibilities. Natural spaces where the visitor can relax during and after meetings such as Bizan and Shinmachigawa, two of Tokushima city's symbols, are abundant.

It is also possible to host conventions in rarely visited places such as the Iya Gorge, one of Japan's three remote locations. Tokushima prefecture provides a support system for visits, hosting expenses and after convention activities in order to provide you with the best convention stage. Tokushima Prefecture will subsidize conventions held in the prefecture for large groups from all over Japan, as well as subsidize conventions held in prefectural facilities that are booked for more than 100 nights of lodging total.

#### (2) Subsidies for facilities use

Large conventions that book more than 1,000 nights total are eligible to receive a subsidy equivalent in amount to the fee charged for using Tokushima prefectural public facilities (use free of charge). \* The use fee for auxiliary facilities and equipment, however, shall be exempt from the subsidy.

#### (3) Other subsidies

Conventions booking more than 300 nights total lodging are eligible to receive an additional subsidy if they do the following:

# Town of Zomeki

Tokushima developed on a sandbar along the Yoshino River nearly 400 years ago. In the castle towns where enormous wealth was amassed through indigo and salt, commoners devoted their lives to artistic activities, showing great enthusiasm for the Awa Odori Dance and Joruri Puppet theater. Such artistic traditions are still alive, and when artistic performances

are held in these normally quiet towns, the people show a passionate enthusiasm for the performances. Such artistic and musical traditions as the colorful Awa Odori dance and the buoyant sounds of the shamisen--often called "Zomeki"--embody the spirit of Tokushima City.



"Awa Odori Dance" which draws nearly 1.3 million during 4 days. ranks with the Carnival of Rio.

## Awa Odori

Awa Odori is the largest festival in the prefecture, a tradition that has been passed down over the generations for more than 400 years. It is also one of the largest dance festivals in the world, measuring up with the likes of the Rio Carnival! More than 1,300,000 visitors come to Tokushima each year from August 12 to 15 to find the entire prefecture caught up in Awa Odori fever, and there are twelve large stages that are erected in Tokushima City for displays of the dance. It is also held in the cities of Naruto and Miyoshi, as well as other locations throughout the prefecture



## Awa Joruri **Puppet theater**



Awa Puppet Theatre is a melding of simple puppet plays with joruri, an ancient form of dramatic narrative accompanied by shamisen music. Unlike bunraku puppet theatre found in Osaka that was enjoyed by the upper classes, the roots of Awa Puppet Theatre are found in the popular entertainment of farming people, through its large and flamboyant movements, loud recitation style, and simple melodies. Another of its defining feature is the use of very large wooden puppets, called deko. Awa Puppet Theatre is performed in Tokushima, most regularly on the stage of the Awa Jurobei Yashiki.

## **Bizan overlooking** the town of Zomeki Bizan

It is said that Bizan took its name from the fact that its shape looks like an eyebrow when seen from any direction. Bizan's gentle mountain contour with an elevation of 290m is even mentioned in Man'yoshu poetry, and the people have adored Bizan as a symbol of Tokushima. From Bizan's peak, the climber can see Tokushima's cityscape. Ohnaruto Bridge. the Inland Sea, and afar off Awaji Island and the Kishu mountains. Bizan is rich with natural beauty through all seasons, including the cherry blossoms in the spring and autumn leaves in the fall. Further, it is well known for its beautiful night views, having been chosen as one of the top 20 night views in Japan, which surely contributes to the memorable time visitors have in Tokushima.





# Relaxed Tour of Remote Areas

## The remote areas of **Oboke and Koboke**

In Oboke gorge you can find a series of bluish gray fantastically-shaped rocks stretched out for about 5 kilometers. An extraordinary scenery can be seen in springtime when vivid azalea flowers show their faces through fresh green, and in autumn when both shores are trimmed by red leaves. In Koboke gorge downstream, serpentine rapid stream resembling a wriggling dragon hit on rocks. The area is an excellent spot for rafting.

#### - Going Down the River

Ride on a sightseeing excursion ship at the bottom of the ravine feeling limpid water and liver breeze on your cheek, and you will be surrounded by a stunningly beautiful panorama.

## Iya Gorge

Go deeper into the forest from the Oboke gorge along the lya River flowing at the bottom of the V-shaped valley, to find the legend of the Taira samurai family

who escaped into the forest after being defeated by the Minamotos. The Kazura bridge of Iya, one of the three most unusual bridges over lya river, is a suspension bridge of woven vines that can be cut off anytime when pursuers are closing in. The double Kazura bridge in the upper stream of the lya river can also make us imagine the life of the Taira family at the time.

## - Iva Vine Bridge



(a species of vine) and suspended 14 meters above the surface of the river. Although the bridge is reinforced by wire ropes for sightseeing visitors, it swings when you cross it, and most people freeze when seeing the river surface under their feet



**Relaxed** Tour of Remote Areas

Ride on JR Tokushima Line and Dosan Line from Tokushima City for about two hours, there you find Oboke and Koboke, most unexplored regions in western Japan, and Iya Valley in which Taira Family legend is being passed through generations. The regions are located in the upstream area of the great river, Yoshino River, which flows from west to east in Tokushima Prefecture, and around Tsurugi Mountain Semi-national Park spreading around Tsurugi Mountain (1955 meters above sea level), which is one of one-hundred top mountains of Japan.


# Naruto Whirlpools

Naruto Straits lies between Naruto City, Tokushima Prefecture, the southwestern part of Awaji Island, and Hyogo Prefecture. Naruto Whirlpool is known as one of the world's three strongest currents, joining Messina Straits in Italy and Seymour Narrows in Canada.

The recurring whirlpools can reach a size of more than 20 meters. The whirlpools turn at speeds of 20 km per hour, roaring so loud that you feel as if you might be pulled inside.







Naruto Straits has a width of only 1,400 meters. The fast current forms from the ocean water that gushes into the narrow channel with the ebb and flow of the tide between Seto Inland Sea and the Pacific Ocean. In addition, the complicated terrain at ocean floor contributes to the countless whirlpools that appear.

The whirlpools constantly grow and converge with each other, whirling clockwise and then counter clockwise in response to the changing current. The roaring whirlpools retreat and eventually disappear into Kii Channel and Harima-Nada Sea. It is believed that Naruto (Roaring Seto) was named after this roaring sound.

## Whirlpool highlights


The best time to observe the whirlpools is an hour and a half before and after the ebb and flow of the tide, which happens twice a day. Unfortunately, the whirlpools stay on the ocean surface for less than a minute. It's important to plan ahead by using a tide table before going to watch the whirlpool.

The best time to catch the big, dynamic whirlpools is during the spring and fall when tidal changes are at their maximum. The whirlpools can reach up to 20 meters and are believed to be among the largest in the world.

#### - Spectacular views of the ocean

• Uzu-no-michi

A 450-meter walkway built inside the bridge beams (beneath the road) of Ohnaruto Bridge. which spans the channel waters. At the end of

visitors to experience the mystery of nature.



The Otsuka Museum of Art is a " Ceramic board masterpiece art museum" with the largest exhibition space in Japan (total floor of 29.412 square meters), built to commemorate the Otsuka Pharmaceutical Group's 75th anniversary in Naruto City, Tokushima Prefecture. Inside, there are more than 1,000 replicas of priceless masterpieces of Western art from ancient murals to contemporary paintings from more than 190 art museums in 25 countries worldwide. These masterpieces

are reproduced to their original size on the ceramic panels by special printing technique. Unlike the small size photographs of the paintings in art books or textbooks, visitors will be able to appreciate the true artistic value in the original size, and appreciate the works of the major art museums of the world while being in Japan. different structure, where the hill was hollowed in order to protect the beautiful



In June 1st 1918, during World War I, Beethoven's Ninth Symphony was played for the first time in Asia by German soldiers who were detained as prisoners of war in Bando, Naruto City, Tokushima Prefecture.

Bando, Naruto City, right near the first fudasho (temples where amulets are distributed to pilgrims) of the Shikoku Pilgrimage, has a long tradition of hospitality that was seen when Toyohisa Matsue, head of Bando prisoners of war camp, gave German soldiers freedom and a warm welcome. Soon good mutual

relationships were developed beyond country borders between the German soldiers and the local people. In the camp, soldiers engaged in sport and music playing, and volunteered in activities using new techniques for agriculture, stock raising and bread making. The arch of the bridge they built still remains today. The building of the bridge was believed to have become their life purpose as they were not informed of the war situation. It is these circumstances that lead to the performance of the Ninth Symphony. Today, Naruto City German Museum

Shikoku has a pilgrimage culture that includes a circuit of 88 sacred temples. Tokushima, where the first 23 temples on the circuit are located, is called Hosshin-no-Dojo ("awakened mind"). Hosshin-no-Dojo is believed to refer to the spirit needed to seek the courage and enlightenment to take the first step on a long journey, the beginning of a journey that will traverse nearly 1,400 km along the Shikoku pilgrimage circuit.

Why do people embark upon pilgrimages to the temples? Some go on the pilgrimage to heal their hearts, others to hold a memorial service for a departed soul, some to rediscover themselves, others pilgrimage when they feel unhappy at their work, some to heal an illness, others to repent, some to stay healthy, and others to go sightseeing, and so on. There's a different reason for every person.

## Kukai and Hosshin-no-Dojo.



Every pilgrim is impressed with the spirit of hospitality that the people of Shikoku

or hospitality, which was key to Tokyo's successful bid for the Olympics, is found everywhere in Shikoku. The word "ohenrosan" also has a tone of reverence, which allows people to experience the faith of "Doko Futari" (companion travelers)--the pilgrims who constantly walked side by side with Kobo Daishi Kukai during his training. By accompanying Kukai, pilgrims acquired enormous power to keep walking. Even beginners can enjoy the pilgrimage circuit,

changes into brown but once it is exposed to air it turns into a deep. clear green. While the fabric dries, it turns to bright blue. By repeating the dyeing process, the color turns even more blue. The Chinese thinker Junshi wrote, "The blue color extracted from indigo is even more blue than indigo itself." The mystery of indigo gave rise to the saying that "although the blue color is taken from indigo, the extracted blue is even deeper than the indigo ingredient itself".



The museum specializes in the indigo "Ai-no-Yakata." The building was originally the residence of an indigo merchant which tells of a time of prosperity. The exhibition shows indigo cultivation and processing. The visitors can experience indigo dyeing.

## The color of the Japanese soul Japan Blue.

A British man who visited Japan at the beginning of the Meiji era described the beautiful color with the words "Japan Blue" when he saw people who lived surrounded by things dyed in indigo, such as clothing, furniture, and bedding. Even though we use a single word for indigo, in fact, there is a variety of colors derived from indigo, such as white suffused with a subtle blue hue, indigo white, deep navy blue and so on. For instance, indigo that is so deep that it almost appears black was called

"Kachiiro," and because it sounds like the phrase "winning color" in Japanese, it was used to dye military armor for luck; it was also used for samurai family celebrations. At the same time, indigo was inexpensive and could be used to dye any kind of fabric, which made it very popular with every social class from commoners to the Shogun. Eventually indigo came to permeate deep inside the Japanese heart.

Richly flavorful, Awa Wasanbon sugar is now in big demand as a sweetener for high-end Japanese-style confectionery all over Japan. The sugar is now spreading to western sweets and cooking

## Bamboo dolls totensis

Bamboo dolls that sound like musicians playing the festive rhythms of the Awa Odori Dance. The dolls are made by hand using bamboo from Tokushima, and each one of them has its own unique movement and facial expression. which perfectly describes the uplifting feeling of the Awa Odori Dance.



# Wasanbon Sugar



It is believed that the origin of Awa Japanese paper goes back 1,300 years ago when the ancestor of Awa Inbeuji came to Awa Country and started making paper and fabric. The production of Awa Japanese paper flourished, along with indigo and wasanbon sugar, during the Edo period. Awa paper's superior characteristics, such as its water-resistance tear-resistance thinness and light weight, makes it especially suitable for computer printing paper.



#### おおたにやき Otani Potterv

Otani Pottery is made with a unique technique called "Nerokuro" and its best-known pot is the large-sized water lily pot. Recently, it's not just the large-size pottery that have become popular but also practical items full of earthy warmth and folk simplicity, as well as countless interior products.



## Shiiiraori

Awa Shijiraori was originally made at the beginning of the Meiji period. Its unique waffle texture called Shibo is generated through surface tension created by the number of and combination of warp and woof. The cotton makes the fabric feel soft and light and easy to ware, and doesn't stick to sweaty skin due to micro Shibo. The fabric feels fresh and perfectly suited for summer weather





In Tokushima, indigo dyed fabric is dyed through a method called Hakkodate using Awa indigo as an ingredient. As the saying goes -- "the color of blue extracted from indigo is a deeper blue than indigo itself"-- indigo dye adds a deep and beautiful texture when the fabric is washed. In Tokushima, it's not just the kimonos but other dresses, small everyday-use items, accessories, and interior products that are dyed with indigo.

## The kingdom of root vegetables. Tokushima brand vegetables

Naruto Kintoki is grown in sandy soil containing rich minerals and is characterized by its warm, soft. chestnut-like texture. moisture. sweetness and its shiny golden color

Tokushima boasts the second largest harvest of Renkon lotus root in Japan. Tokushima Renkon lotus root is characterized by its distinctive fragrance, almost transparent whiteness, sheen, and crunchy texture.



Tokushima yields the top harvest of carrots (spring carrots) in Japan. Carrots cultivated by farmers with care by incorporating "tunnel cultivating," which raises the temperature in the ground and contributes to early harvest of carrots, are rich in carotene and sweet and soft.



Japanese black cattle raised in the mild climate and abundant nature of Tokushima, "Awagyu" Approximately 2,000 cattle of grade 4 quality or higher with a clear pedigree are shipped annually The superior feed techniques of cattle ranchers in

Tokushima Prefecture make the beef highly valued in the marketplace for the color of its fat and its marble-like tenderness that melts in the mouth and is delicious to the taste

## Awa Conger

The high-quality ingredients that add color to the summer table. Common Japanese Conger. It's an essential ingredient especially in Kansai areas such as Kyoto Gion Festival and Osaka Tenjin Festival. Actually, most Common Japanese Conger are harvested in Tokushima

There are two seasons for Common Japanese Conger, from June through July and from November through December. In addition to summer Common Japanese Conger with its elegant, simple taste, enjoy conger fattened during the autumn and the winter, which are also excellent. Some are said to weigh as much as500  $\sim$ 600g. Dishes that use Common Japanese Conger are well-known, such as parboil, sashimi, hamonabe, and dobinmushi.

## Naruto Wakame home



Tokushima has always been rich in wild wakame, and which was even mentioned in thousand-year documents as a gift from the Awa region

Naruto wakame, grown and tossed about in the strong tidal current, is characterized by its thickness, firm texture, good flavor and bright green color. There are three types of wakame: Shiokura Wakame salted after blanching the raw seaweed and cooling it with cold water in order to enhance its preservability and its fine taste; blanched Shiokura Wakame rinsed with water: and Naruto Ito Wakame which is dried and shredded into thread-like strands.

## Awaodori

No chicken dish in Tokushima surpasses that of Awaodori. It tastes great baked, boiled, fried, or stir-fried. Its good quality meat puts it in demand among professional chefs and typical households. Sauté chicken thigh is what brings out the best. The ideal is crunchy skin and juicy meat. When breast meat is lightly salted and smoked, it yields a texture like ham and a deep flavor.

## Naruto seabream



The red seabream tossing about in Naruto Straits is a high-end fish called Naruto seabream. Its firm texture and bright color makes it stand out. In the spring when seabream are getting ready to spawn they are called "Sakuradai" and in the autumn when they are ripe for harvesting they are called "Koyodai." Seabream taste the best during these two seasons.









## Sudachi Itt

Tokushima's representative specialty product is a type of citrus. Sudachi can be enjoyed in a variety of ways, such as squeezing juice on top of pickled vegetables and baked fish, and floating slices on sake and shochu. Sudachi is used in vinegar and jam, miso soybean paste, and various other processed foods.
