[World Heritage Site · Mt. Fuji]

Mt. Fuji is now the treasure of Japan and the world both in name and substance as a registered World Heritage Site. A full range of facilities and spots in Eastern Shizuoka Prefecture, proud of its scenic beauty and spectacular views, attracts people from across Japan and all over the world.

[Industry]

Eastern Shizuoka Prefecture is also a region that has supported the heart of Japan since ancient times. Traditional industries have been passed down since long ago in an unbroken chain, modern industrial heritage since the Meiji Period is well-represented by the Nirayama Reverberatory Furnaces and industries of today demonstrate cutting edge technology.

[Transportation Access]

Eastern Shizuoka Prefecture, an hour's ride from the center of Tokyo by shinkansen to Atami-Mishima, offers an attractive sense of distance. By opening the Shin-Tomei Expressway and improving access roads, access by car from the base of Mt. Fuji to Izu Peninsula has improved significantly.

[History · Culture]

The thousand year history of Japan is well-preserved in Eastern Shizuoka Prefecture, from the middle ages when it was closely linked to the traditional capital to raising Minamoto no Yoritomo's army during the warring states Sengoku period. From the Edo Period culture flourished along the Tokaido Road to the opening up of the country, as represented by the Nirayama Reverberatory Furnaces and the path to the modern age.

[Food]

Eastern Shizuoka Prefecture is prominently featured in its variety of foods, from the village tastes of deep in the mountain countryside to the seasonal delicacies from the sea and the delicious fruits produced by the warm climate. Feel and savor the freshness and deliciousness of the region's “foods of the season.”

[Nature]

The difference in elevations from the top of Mt. Fuji at 7,000m to Suruga Bay, the deepest sea depth along the coast of Japan, tells its own story of the rich and abundant nature of the 4 seasons. Izu Velodrome (Izu City)

Events and get-together party functions at this indoor bicycle race course, the only indoor course in Japan that conforms to international regulations

Points of Plan

- ① [Izu Velodrome], the first indoor bicycle race course in Japan, used as a conference forum.
- ② For get-together party functions while watching bicycle races popular in Europe and the United States.
- ③ Experience riding on a wooden track with a maximum slope of 45°.

Recommended Points

- ★ Ride a specially-designed bicycle on the wooden 250m track with a maximum slope of 45°.
- ★ Conferences held in the conference room have a capacity of 30 persons in the Velodrome.
- ★ Can be used for various functions and events.

- Fixed Fee: 291,000 yen ~ *Weekdays, using permanent spectator seating (6 hours get-together party functions from 16:00)
- Conference room (1) accommodating 30 persons in the Velodrome: 2,000 yen per hour

Plaza Verde

(Numazu City)

The largest multipurpose convention complex in Shizuoka Prefecture with convention halls, an exhibition hall, meeting rooms and accommodation facilities.



This facility is located just a 3 minute walk from the North Exit of JR Numazu Station. The multipurpose hall, with a total floor space of 3875m², a ceiling height of 12.6m, has no pillars and the floor is concrete. As large vehicles can directly enter and exit the hall, deliveries and pick-ups operate seamlessly. Past performances held include the Russia National Bolshoi Circus and music concerts, exhibitions, sales events and sporting events. At “Convention Hall A,” accommodating about 1,000 persons, which offers the largest convention facility in the Prefecture, a 300-inch screen is equipped. The hall can also be divided into 2 sections, allowing for a meeting to be held in one section and a reception to be held in the other. At “Convention Hall B,” accommodating about 400 persons, simultaneous interpretation booths can be set up for international conferences. The extensive space accommodates not only events and lecture meetings but also receptions. There are 14 meeting rooms, which are available for seminars, training sessions, section meetings and small study groups. The hotel combines 150 guest rooms and convention facilities allowing guests to directly access the convention hall from the hotel front floor.

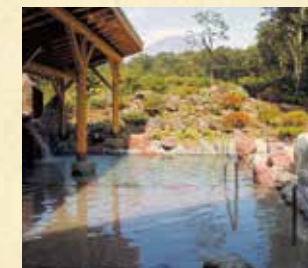

Izu Peninsula Geopark

Did you know that the formation of the Izu Peninsula is completely different from other parts of Honshu (the Main Island of Japan)?

In prehistory times (about 20 million years ago), Izu Peninsula was once a submarine volcano group in the Pacific Ocean to the far south of Honshu.

This volcanic group moved northward with the Philippine Plate and then collided with Honshu to form the peninsula. There are more than 300 precious geo-points showing this geologic evidence, most of which are tourist spots.

Check Out Geo

A considerable portion of the city of Mishima sits on the lava streams of Mt. Fuji. You can see up close very rare shaped rocks such as the cross-section of lava streams at the North Exit of JR Mishima Station (less than a minute walk) and the ropy lava and lava tunnel in Rakujuen at the South Exit (5 min. walk), which almost allows us to forget the fact that we are in front of a shinkansen station.



Rakujuen (Mishima City): Tour held every day is recommended.



North Exit of Mishima Station (Mishima City): Underneath the elevated railway tracks of the shinkansen, you can observe the lava.



Tensodo (Nishi-Izu Town): A cave created by waves (Sea cave).



All Day Geo

If you have a whole day, why not make a little side trip to Nishi-Izu and Minami-Izu? Magnificent landscapes, created by submarine volcanos and erosion, await your discovery, including Dogashima, Senkanmon and Cape Ai-ai.

Geo Side Trip

If you have half a day, why not enjoy a side trip to Ito and Shuzenji? You can climb Mt. Omuro, which has the appearance of a serving of pudding, by lift and observing the landscape from an altitude of 580m is fantastic. At Asahi Falls, cool water flows down in beautiful columnar joints providing refreshing relief.



Mt. Omuro (Ito City): A mountain with a beautiful silhouette of a mild curve like a turned-down bowl.



Asahi Falls (Izu City): A shape formed by cooled magma.



Senkanmon (Matsuzaki Town): The name was so given because it was worth the visit paying 1,000 kan.



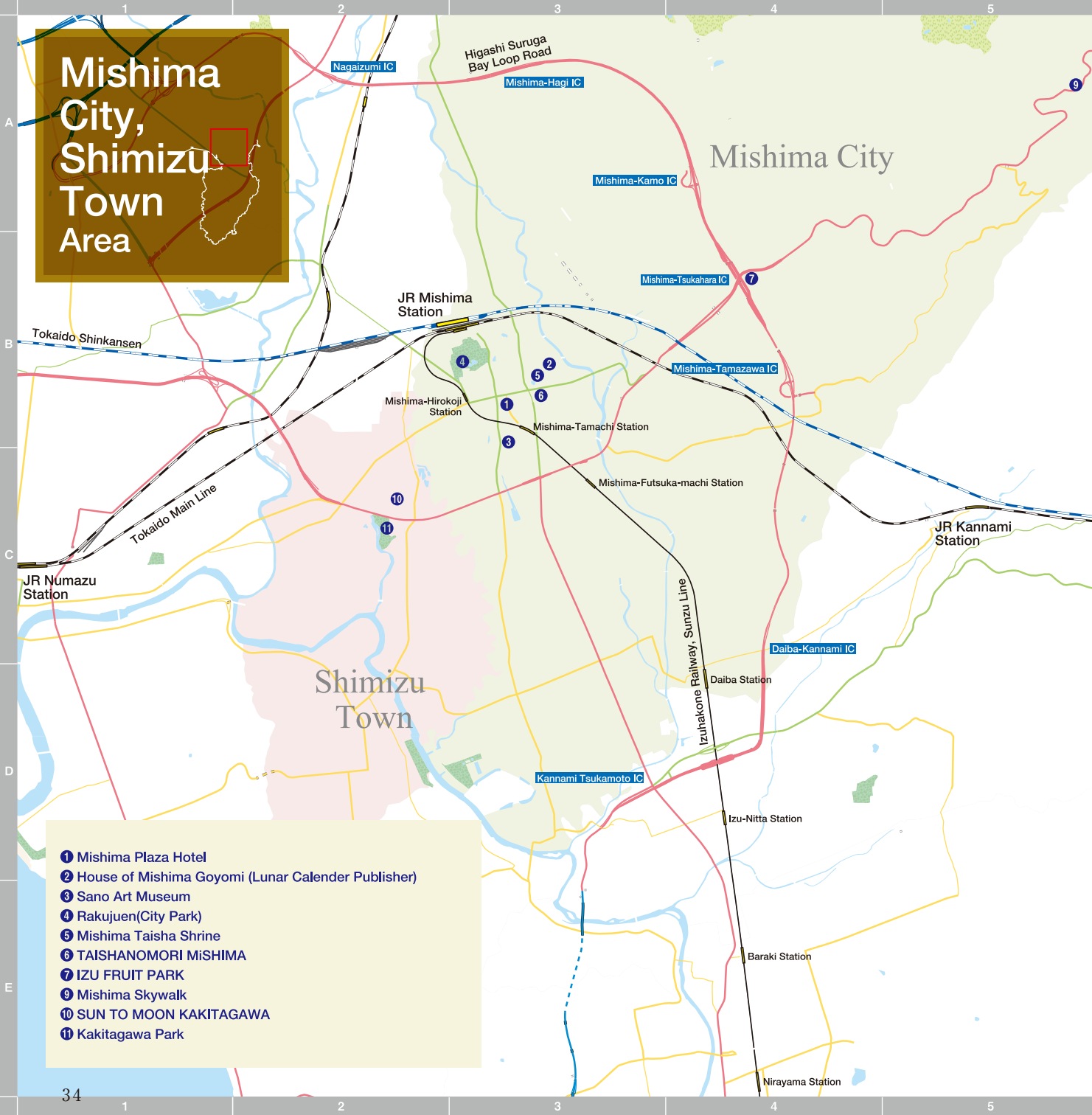
