Oshu Sendai Omotenashi Group Date Busho Tai Warriors

This show is derived from Sendai's most famous Feudal Lord, Date Masamune of some 400 years ago. The group performs martial arts to give you a taste of the spirit and charm of Date Masamune. Enjoy this samurai performance!



This dance represents local Sendai entertainment and is said to have begun in 1603 as a dance to celebrate the completion of the walls of Sendai Castle. The dance can be arranged for various sized stages and times. Enjoy the uplifting performance!





Shibata Siblings (Tsugaru Shamisen)

The group plays the Tsugaru shamisen and has won 38 shamisen championships nationally. Enjoy the strength and melancholic tone of their music.



Kamo Tsunamura Drums

This Japanese drum playing group represents Sendai and performs 50 stages both in and out of Sendai every year. Enjoy the intensity of their performance.

Entsuin

This is the mausoleum and family temple of Mitsumune, a descendent of Date Masamune. It is located in Matsushima, known as one of the three most beautiful scenic spots in Japan. Nearby is the Zuiganji Temple, a national treasure of Japan. You can dine here while enjoying the beautiful scenery of the changing seasons such as roses in summer and coloured leaves in the autumn.

The old Date mansion – Shokeikaku – a Sendai city designated tangible cultural property

The structure is made of carefully selected pine wood and is over 200 years old. It is a predominantly single story building with a second floor over one part. The total area of the building is over 700m².

Akiu Craft Park

There are nine ateliers with craftsmen producing traditional crafts. You can view the craftsmen practice their skills first hand, or, alternatively have them teach you and have a go yourself.

Kokeshi (wooden dolls) Painting: Time required: 1 hour
Cost: ¥1,000 pp approx. Number of people: 1 to 65 max.
Handkerchief Dyeing: Time required: 1 hour
Cost: ¥1,500 pp approx. Number of people: 2 to 30 max.
Chopsticks Lacquering: Time required: 40 mins.
Cost: ¥1,300 pp approx. (postage extra) Number of people: 3 to 20 max.
Spinning Top Painting: Time required: 15 mins.
Cost: ¥1,000 pp approx. (postage extra) Number of people: 1 to 20 max.

Beer Brewery Kirin Beer Sendai Plant
