

Why Shizuoka Central Area?



Shizuoka area lies in the central part of the Shizuoka prefecture. The town has been highly favored by famous Japanese artists, and much of its historical architecture still remains providing visitors with lots to see. That said there are a lot of modern industrial facilities too. With a major venue which has held a convention on disarmament sponsored by the United Nations, the area plays a role as a prefectural capital.


Largest Growing Area of World Famous Green Tea

Being Japan's largest growing area, Shizuoka green tea is referred to as one of the two best districts for Japanese tea. Shizuoka tea, which is finished by a master's hand work, is presented to the imperial family every year. The diversity of the tastes, derived from differences between production areas and methods, attracts great attention from abroad, and international events like the World O-CHA(Tea) Festival have been held here.

While historical spots, such as 'Kunozan Toshogu' that enshrines Shogun Tokugawa leyasu and 'Shizuoka Sengen Shrine' that is one of Japan's important national cultural properties still remain, there are also major industrial facilities in Shizuoka central area. 
Unparalleled Commodious Halls Filled with Bright Natural Light Suitable for Gatherings of All Kinds


