The Eminent Hamamatsu Castle

Hamamatsu Castle served as the headquarters of Tokugawa Ieyasu's government for 17 years, from the time he was 29-45 years of age. During this time, the battles of Anegawa, Nagashino, Komaki, Nagakute, and Mikatagahara all took place. It must have been a period of patience and perseverance for Ieyasu, as he had to overcome many trials to build up and strengthen his forces. After moving to Sunpu Castle, he still felt a deep affinity to Hamamatsu Castle, and thus made sure it was well protected and maintained. He appointed a number of important officials to reside over it, which garnered its title as being an "eminent castle". Among these officials was Mizuno Tadakuni, who instituted the Tenpo Reforms. Reaping the benefits of his relationship with Ieyasu, it is said that he requested to become the lord of Hamamatsu Castle.

Hamamatsu the Music Capital

Hamamatsu has a long tradition of being a center of music culture, which has earned it the honor of being referred to as a "music capital." The headquarters of world-renowned instrument manufacturers Yamaha, Kawai, and Roland are all located in Hamamatsu. Hamamatsu is a UNESCO-certified City of Music and was the first to be recognized as such in Asia.

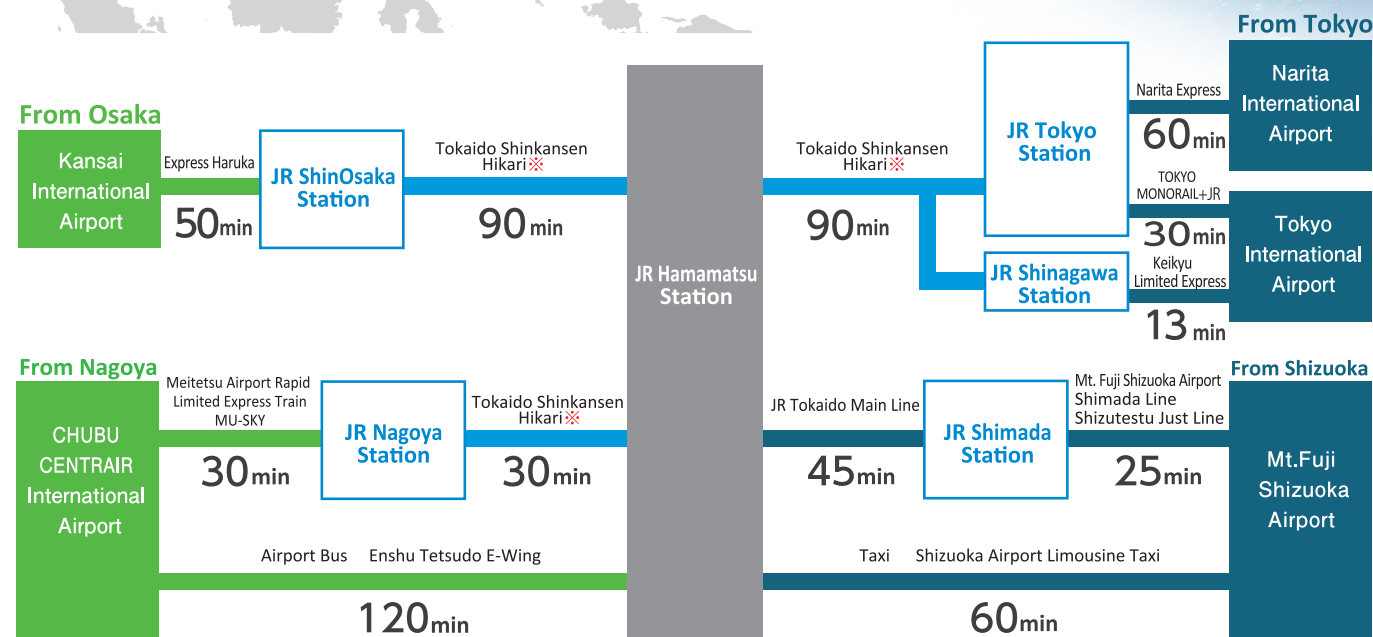
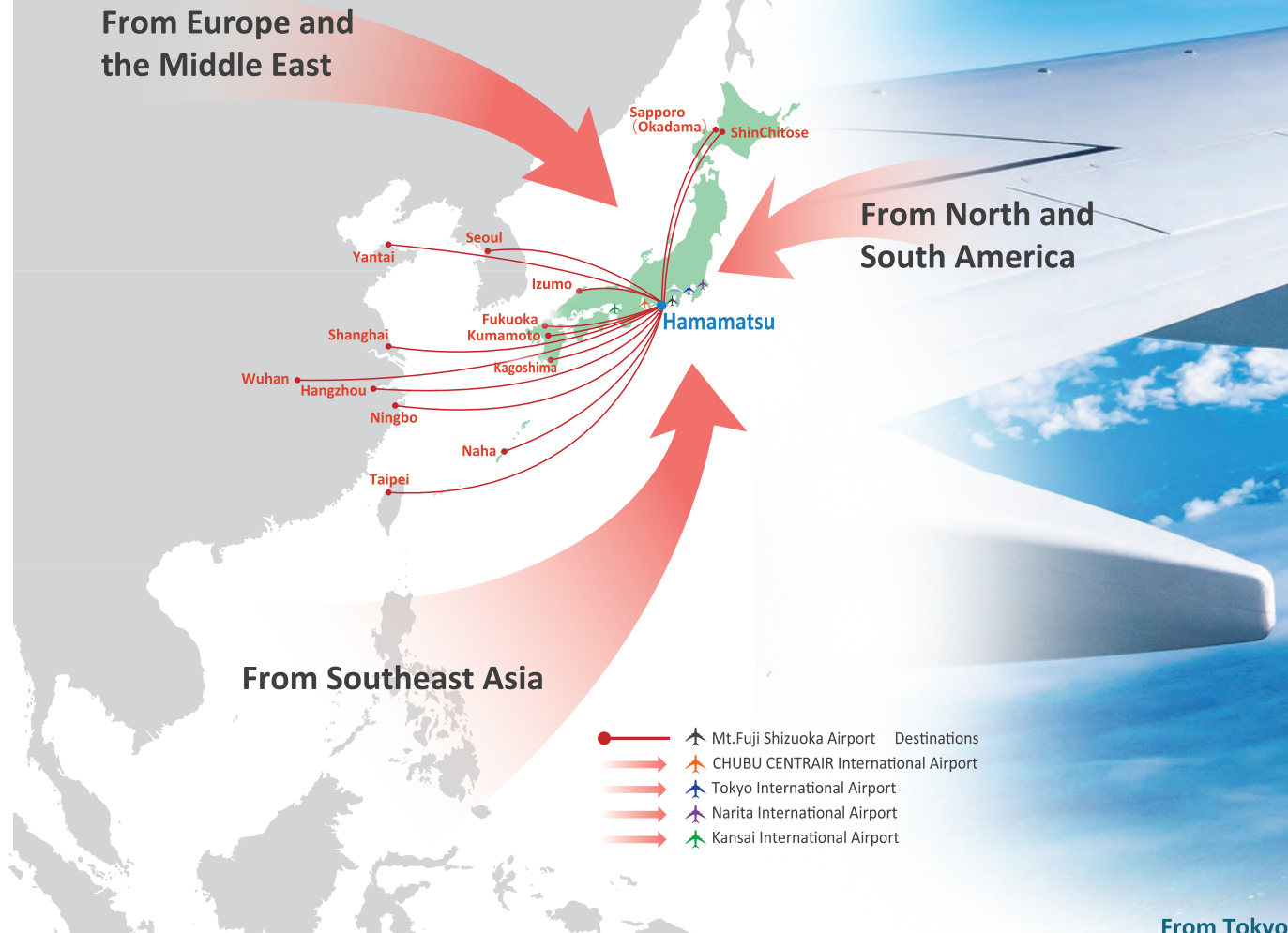

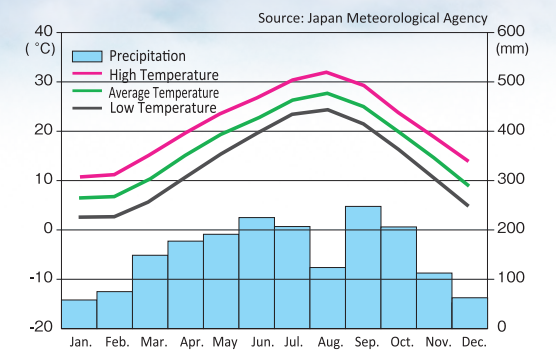

Hamamatsu is situated roughly at the halfway point between Tokyo and Osaka. You will not find a more conveniently located place in Japan for international conferences or corporate meetings, nor for medical, science, technology, industry, sports, art, and cultural conventions. Hamamatsu is only around an hour and a half by shinkansen from both Tokyo and Osaka. Furthermore, it is only about an hour by car from the Mt. Fuji Shizuoka Airport, which offers domestic flights to and from Fukuoka, Okinawa, Kagoshima, Kumamoto, Sapporo-Okudama, ShinChitose, and Izumo Airport, as well as international flights to and from Seoul, Taipei, Hangzhou, Ningbo, and Yantai. You can choose from a wide variety of ways to get to and from the city, whether it be via shinkansen, the Tomei Expressway, or airplane. We truly hope you consider hosting your MICE event in Hamamatsu.

The Climate of Hamamatsu A mild climate throughout the year

Hamamatsu is blessed with a distinct four seasons thanks to its proximity to the ocean, yet maintains a mild climate throughout the year, and is not heavily impacted by stormy weather like typhoons. There is little to no snowfall or extreme cold fronts even in the middle of winter, so there is pretty much no need for thick winter coats.

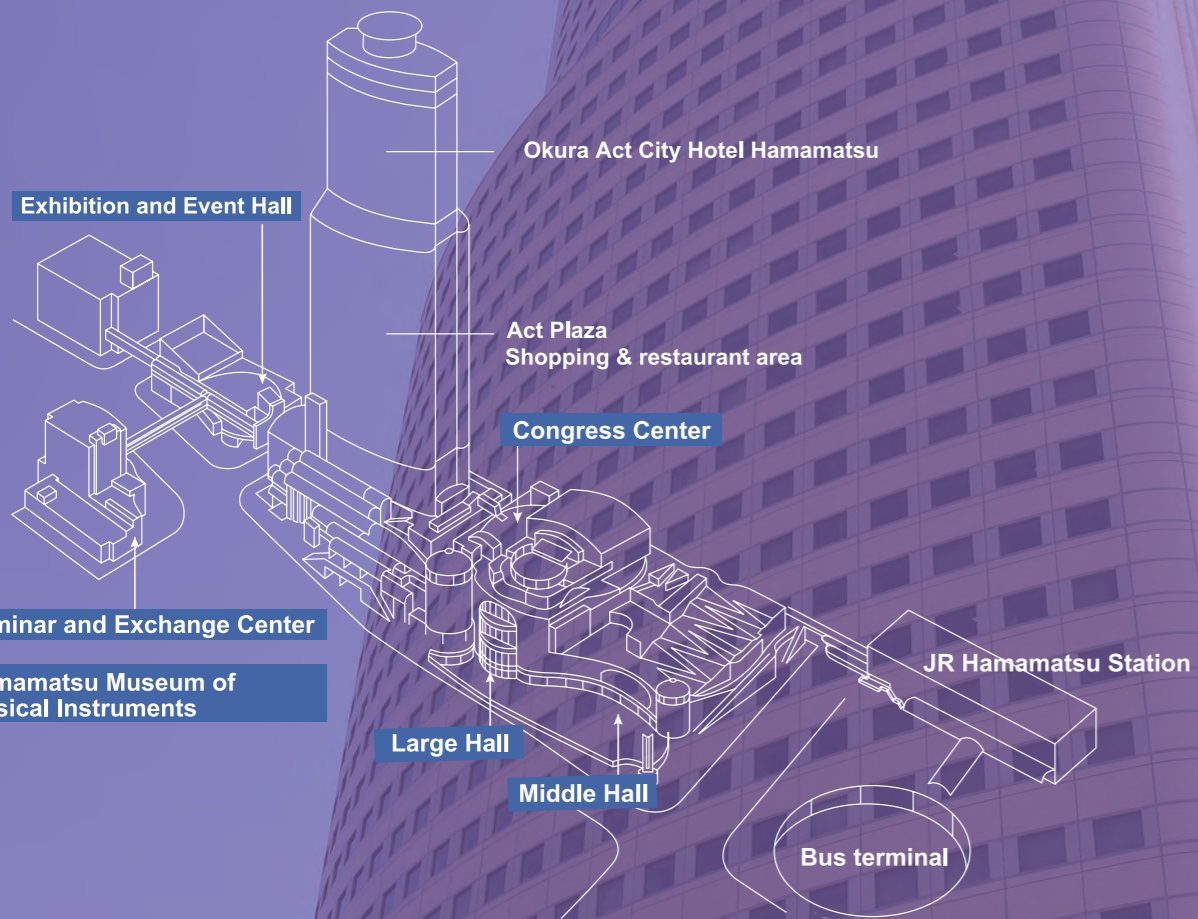

Act City Hamamatsu Connected to JR Hamamatsu Station

Act City Hamamatsu is located just a one-minute walk from JR Hamamatsu Station, a busy station along the Tokaido Shinkansen Line. Act City serves as the meeting, information, and activity hub of Hamamatsu. It features a number of municipal and private facilities, including its middle and large-size performance halls, a Congress Center, the Okura Act City Hotel Hamamatsu, a variety of specialty shops in Act Tower, an exhibition and event hall, the Hamamatsu Museum of Musical Instruments, a seminar and exchange center, and office space. From conferences of up to 5,000 people to large-scale exhibitions, it can cover just about any need you may have.

Act City features large-scale, high-performance composite facilities like its exhibition and event hall and large performance hall.

The exhibition and event hall featured a turnout of approximately 8,000 visitors over a two-day period when the Hamamatsu Business Matching Fair was held there.



Large Hall

This multipurpose performance hall boasts Japan's first four-sided stage and can fit up to 2,336 people. Its design and layout also allow for a comfortable seminar-style atmosphere, making it perfect for international conventions as well. The seats are of the highest quality, keeping attendees comfortable for prolonged periods of time. It also comes equipped with a 500-inch screen and simultaneous interpretation are available in 6 languages.



Middle Hall

The middle hall features functions that allow for classical music performances at the highest level. It also comes equipped with convention features that include simultaneous interpretation in four languages and a 400-inch screen. The seats are of the same quality as those in the large hall, and all the seats on the first floor come equipped pull-out tables. A French Pipe Organ with 64' stops is equipped at the front of the stage, and the chandelier hanging from the ceiling provides a calm presence for brilliant performances.



Exhibition and Event Hall

This vast 100m X 35m space comes equipped with horizontal and vertical pits along the floor that allow for easy access to electricity, water supply, and drainage, and telephone installation. Moreover, it comes complete with six break rooms, a central office for event organizers, and operational support facilities for large-scale exhibitions and events. It is perfect for events such as trade fairs, exhibitions, and all kinds of other dedicated events.



Seminar and Exchange Center

Located in the same building as the instrument museum, the center features ten conference rooms and 14 music seminar rooms from the 2nd to 6th floors. Equipped with a concert piano, the music workshop hall can be used for a wide variety of purposes, such as piano, jazz, wind instrument, and chamber music concerts and seminars. The music seminar rooms come equipped with an array of instruments, such as a grand piano, drum sets, and amps, allowing for anything from individual practice sessions to group lessons, small-scale recitals, and music seminars.

Congress Center

With a total of 13 conference rooms to choose from, the center can be used for everything from small-scale lectures to large-scale academic conferences, ranging from 18-560 people. The center offers a full array of conference equipment, such as microphones and projectors, and the table and chair layouts can be rearranged to meet any client's needs.

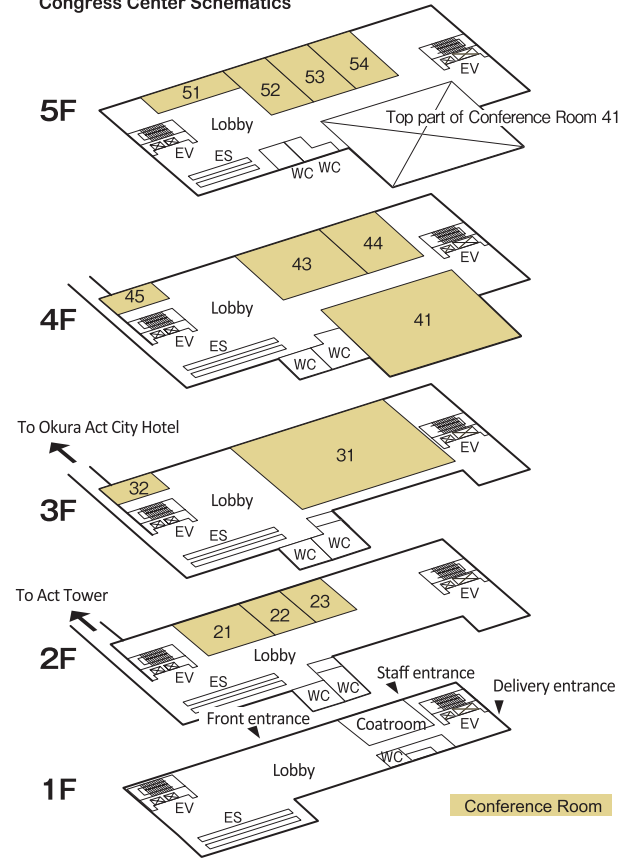


Conference Room 41

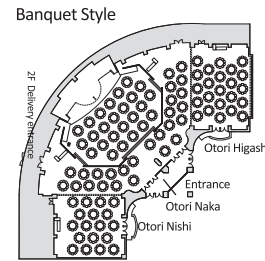
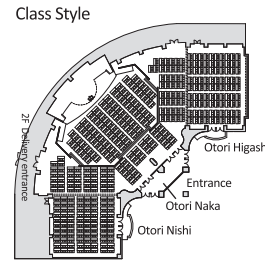

Shizuoka Prefectural Forest Park, Mori-No-Ie Lodge

The multipurpose facility "Mori-No-Ie Lodge" is located in Forest Park, surrounded by a lush natural environment comprised mainly of Japanese red pine trees. It has overnight accommodations, training rooms, a gymnasium, and other facilities, so guests can stay overnight and participate in training while experiencing nature and the seasons. It has sweeping views of Hamamatsu, which can be enjoyed at night as well. The entire building can be reserved for private use, including Yamabiko Hall, the overnight accommodation building, and the management and training rooms.

Hamamatsu Arena, the Furuhashi Hironoshin Memorial Hamamatsu Swimming Pool, and the Hamamatsu City Hamakita General Gymnasium have all been endorsed as training camp venues for the 2020 Tokyo Olympic Games.* They all feature optimal support systems that are guaranteed to satisfy both athletes and spectators.

You can also enjoy concerts in the main arena, which features a maximum capacity of 7,500 people. It has attracted large international basketball and volleyball tournaments in the past.

Hamamatsu Arena

The main arena has played host to a number of large international basketball and volleyball tournaments. The main arena can fit up to 7,500 people, while the sub arena can hold up to 1,400 people. It is also the homecourt for the San-En Neo Phoenix professional basketball team and the Agleymina Hamamatsu professional futsal team. The venue is located fifteen minutes on foot from Tenryugawa Station on the JR Tokaido Main Line, and features 653 parking spaces. In addition to sporting events, it can also be used for concerts, ceremonies, and more.

Sala Green Arena

Sala Green Arena has been established as a venue for the judo portion of the Japan National Athletic Meet. This nearly 13ha verdant site includes a number of facilities, including an arena, a heated pool, soccer grounds, and an open sports square. The main arena features 1070 seats (including ten for wheelchairs), a state-of-the art training room, and expert trainers. Moreover, it is only 15 minutes by car from the Hamakita Interchange on the Shin-Tomei Expressway, and can accommodate up to 300 cars (shared with the soccer grounds).



The 50m pool can be split up into two 25m pools for different uses. (Moving floor)

Internationally accredited main pool and diving pool This pool is perfect for competitive swimming, artistic swimming, and water polo matches.

ToBiO (Furuhashi Hironoshin Memorial Hamamatsu Swimming Pool)

The internationally accredited 50m main pool (10 lanes) features a moving floor, so it can accommodate a variety of water-based competitions. Moreover, the diving pool is also internationally accredited and comes equipped with a moving floor. The facilities include a domestically accredited sub pool (25m X 8 lanes), a leisure pool, restaurant, and Japan Swimming History Archive.
