



The Marine Lobby facing Yokohama Bay has an attractive interior evoking the image of a seashore.





The size of the stage can be adjusted as needed. Some seats in odd-numbered rows on the first floor can recline, for a capacity of 1,670.









The rooms on this floor can be set up for small sessions and meetings or can be used as waiting rooms.






The three main meeting rooms (each approximately 400 m²) are equipped with simultaneous interpretation booths and can be used for various purposes such as international conferences and receptions.
























The 20,000 m² column-free space with a maximum ceiling height of 19 meters can be used for exhibitions, events, ceremonies, and receptions.








NORTH — 2F Floor Plan PACIFICO YOKOHAMA

Effective Sanitation Practices

The cleaning method for the facilities has been fundamentally revised to secure more effective and safe cleaning procedures, including the usage of environmentally friendly chemicals (U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) registered products). By establishing new cleaning methods, we are extending the life of our facilities.







100% Industrial Waste Recycling Initiative

We are actively promoting our initiative to achieve 100% recycling of industrial waste generated at our facilities. Currently, we are recycling approximately 90% of our industrial waste, which is one of the world's highest standards among convention facilities.









Utilization of Rainwater Harvesting System

Rainwater from the roof of the Exhibition Hall is collected, stored, and recycled to conserve water resources. The cumulative rainwater collected since the opening of the Exhibition Hall is equivalent to the volume of 90 Olympic-size swimming pools (225,000 m3). The collected rainwater is used as cooling water for the facilities' private power generators and as toilet water.







Installation of Energy-Efficient and Disaster-Responsive Vending Machines

All of the 100+ vending machines installed throughout our facilities are energy-efficient models that reduce standby power consumption.

A number of these machines are disaster-responsive models, installed to ensure the availability of beverages in the event of a power failure.







The Minatomirai Dai Bon Odori

The "Minatomirai Dai Bon Odori" is a popular annual dance festival that was first planned by PACIFICO Yokohama. The first event was held in 2007, offering a place for the residents and workers of the Minato Mirai 21 district to come together. It has now become one of the major community events in the Minato Mirai 21 district.





PACIFICO Yokohama Evacuation Drill Concert

The "Evacuation Drill Concert" was held to offer the audience and performers (musicians) the opportunity to experience an evacuation from the premises, guided by staff members, under the scenario of an earthquake occurring during a performance.
